APPROVAL BY THE SENATE OF THE ELECTION OFFENCES BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 36 OF 2016) AND THE ELECTION LAWS (AMENDMENT) BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 37 OF 2016)

Honourable Members, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41(5), I wish to report to the House that I received a Message from the Senate regarding the approval, by the Senate, of the following Bills:

- 1. The Election Offences Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 36 of 2016); and
- 2. The Election Laws (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 37 of 2016).

The Message reads, in part, and I quote, "That the Election Offences Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 36 of 2016) and The Election Laws (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 37 of 2016) were passed by the Senate on Thursday, 8th September 2016 without amendments."

Honourable Members, you may recall that the National Assembly had passed the said Bills without amendments on Thursday, 1st September, 2016. In this regard, I will now proceed to present the Bill to the H.E. the President for assent in accordance with the provisions of Articles 110(5) and 113(3) of the Constitution.
