## MESSAGES MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE No.007 of 2016

**Honourable Members**, Standing Order 41 requires the Speaker to expeditiously report to the House any Messages received from the Senate. In this regard, Honourable Members, I wish to report that this afternoon, Thursday, 21<sup>st</sup> April, 2016, I received a Message from the Senate regarding the approval of the Second Basis for Equitable Sharing of National Revenue allocated to Counties.

Honourable Members, as contemplated under Article 217 of the Constitution, the National Assembly may consider the Senate's resolution and vote to approve it with or without amendments, or reject it in *toto*. Hon. Members, this being a Special Motion, the House has fourteen (14) days within which to make a decision in one way or the other. However, since the Formula has implications on the Division of Revenue Bill and the County Allocation of Revenue Bill, it requires to be concluded expeditiously and before the passage of these two Bills. I have therefore allowed the Leader of the Majority to give Notice of Motion on this matter today.

Honorable Members, in this regard the Message and accompanying documents stand committed to the Liaison Committee. The Committee is expected to consider and submit a report to the House by Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> April, 2016 so that the motion may be considered on Thursday next week, the 28<sup>th</sup> day of April 2016.
