Honourable Members,

The Message states, and I quote, 'THAT, the Food Security Bill (Senate Bill No. 23 of 2014) was published in the Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 81 of May 30, 2014 as a Bill originating in the Senate and was passed by the Senate on Wednesday, September 16, 2015 with amendments and in the form attached hereto.' Consequently, and in accordance with the provisions of Article 110 of the Constitution, the Senate now seeks the concurrence of the National Assembly to the said Bill.

Honourable Members, I am aware that the Clerk has circulated the Bill in accordance with our Standing Orders. The Bill may now be scheduled for First Reading after which it shall stand committed to the Budget and Appropriations Committee for consideration in accordance with the provisions of Article 114 of the Constitution. Thereafter, the Bill will stand referred to the Departmental Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and

Cooperatives for consideration pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 127, taking into account the recommendations of the Budget and Appropriations Committee.
