Under the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act,(No.33 of 2011)and the Standing Orders of the Committee ,***The National Assembly shall, within fourteen days of the receipt of the nominees under subsection (7), consider all the nominations received and may approve or reject any nomination***” In this regard, Hon. Members, I wish to guide the Committees and the House as follows-

- (i) The Departmental Committees should notify the Nominees and the general public of the time and place for holding the approval hearings, in good time. In order to manage our time optimally, the notification should therefore be made tomorrow, Wednesday, June 12th , 2013; and,
- (ii) The Committee may therefore undertake the approval hearings between June 17th and 19th, 2013. Thereafter, the Committees should table their Reports before this House on or before June 20th, 2013.
