MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE (NO. 005 of 2015)

Honourable Members,

Standing Order 41 relating to Messages requires the Speaker to expeditiously report to the House any Messages received from the Senate. In this regard, Honourable Members, I wish to report that on Wednesday 25th February, 2014, in accordance with Article 110 (4) of the Constitution, I received two (2) Messages from the Senate regarding the passage of the following two National Assembly Bills.-

- The Fertilizers and Animal Foodstuffs (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No 36 of 2013); and
- The Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No.2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 33 of 2013).

These Bills were referred to the Senate after passage by this House on 19th June 2014 and 23rd July 2014 respectively.

Honourable Members,

The Fertilizers and Animal Foodstuffs (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No 36 of 2013), and the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No.2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 33 of 2013) were passed <u>with amendments</u> by the Senate on **Tuesday**, 17th **February**, 2015. The Senate now seeks the concurrence of the National Assembly to the amendments made to the two Bills.

Honourable Members,

I am aware that the Clerk has since circulated these amendments to all Members in accordance with Standing Order 145. In this regard, the Senate amendments to the **Fertilizers and Animal** Foodstuffs (Amendment) Bill (National Assembly Bill No 36 of 2013) will now stand committed to the Departmental Committee on Agriculture, Livestock and Cooperatives while the amendments to the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) (No.2) Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 33 of 2013) are committed to the Departmental Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs for consideration. The Committees are expected to submit their respective reports to the House within 21 days, to enable the House Business Committee to prioritize their consideration.

Honourable Members,

I wish to remind you that the National Assembly will only consider the amendments made by the Senate to the two Bills, and not any other parts of the Bills. I will guide you further on the procedure to be followed during the debate when the House Business Committee prioritizes these Bills for consideration.
