# MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE (NO. 006 of 2015)

### Honourable Members,

I also wish to convey that I have since received a Message from the Senate regarding the passage of the National Youth Service (Amendment) Bill (Senate Bill No. 26 of 2014). The message states "THAT, the National Youth Service (Amendment) Bill (Senate Bill No. 26 of 2014), which was published in the Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 97 of 27th June, 2014 as a Bill originating from the Senate was passed with amendments by the Senate on Thursday 19th February, 2015. The Senate now seeks the concurrence of the National Assembly on the said Bill.

### Honourable Members,

I am aware that the Clerk has since circulated copies of the Bill, which is scheduled for First Reading today, upon which it will stand referred to the Departmental Committee on Labour and Social Welfare for consideration. The Committee is expected to submit a report before the Bill is considered by the House for Second Reading. I also direct that, before the Bill is scheduled for Second Reading, the Committee must engage the Budget and Appropriations Committee with a view to satisfying the requirement of Article 114 of the Constitution relating to money Bills.
