	Comment: In order to show case best experience of an expert proposed for the assignment, it is requested to kindly increase degree of responsibility held in various assignments from 10 years to 20 years and also requested to kindly consider CV's of professionals signed by authorized person at bidding stage and CV's with signature of key personnel may be submitted at time of contract signing.	
3)	"The bidder shall submit a technical proposal that must give the names and CVs of one (1) lead project manager and two (2) other assistants from diverse backgrounds and as specified in the Terms of Reference." Comment: It is requested to kindly consider only the names of additional staff i.e. 1 No. of Lead Project Manager and 2 Nos. of other assistants during the bidding stage and allow their CVs to be submitted during the contract negotiation or during the contract signing.	The specification in the RFP document suffices. The CVs must be submitted as stated in the RFP document
4)	Kindly consider. As per the tender, the tender security form has to be submitted in the form of Bank Guarantee. It is requested to kindly provide the format for tender security fee or can it be processed in any format. Kindly clarify. 5)	Kindly clarify.
