The following Ordinary Questions were asked -

(i) Question 328/2020 by the Member for Nyandarua County (Hon. Faith Gitau) regarding the capturing of all information and eligible citizens in the *Huduma* Number programme, and the synchronization of information in the national identification cards into the *Huduma* Cards before final roll-out of the programme.
