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SUBJECT: MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT ON NOMINATION OF APPOINTMENTS TO THE OFFICES OF PRINCIPAL SECRETARIES.

#### Honourable Members,

Standing Order 42(1) relating to **Messages from the President** provides that –

"The Speaker shall read to the House any message from the President delivered to the Speaker for communication to the House".

Further, Article 132(2)(d) of the Constitution states that -

"The President shall nominate and, with the approval of the National Assembly, appoint, Principal Secretaries";

In this regard, **Hon. Members,** I wish to convey the following Message from His Excellency the President, regarding nomination of a various persons for appointment as Principal Secretaries.

Section 8 of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act requires the National Assembly consider such nominees <u>within</u> <u>twenty eight (28) days</u>.

In this regard, and to enable the House conclude this exercise, I direct the Clerk of the National Assembly to take the necessary action by notifying the nominees and the general public by placing an advert in the daily newspapers of national circulation and the Parliamentary Website of the time and place of holding the approval hearings tomorrow, **Friday**, **4**<sup>th</sup> **November**, **2022**, following which the vetting hearings should commence on **Monday**, **14**<sup>th</sup> **November 2022** and end by **Friday**, **18**<sup>th</sup> **November**, **2022**.

Thereafter, the Departmental Committees should table their reports in the House not later than **Tuesday**, **22**<sup>nd</sup> **November**, **2022** in order for the House to consider the nominees **within the statutory timelines**.
