Notification of nomination

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 155(3)(a) of the Constitution, H.E. the President and Commander in Chief of the Defence Forces of the Republic of Kenya is empowered to nominate and with the approval of the National Assembly, appoint Principal Secretaries to State Departments. In exercise of the said powers, H.E. the President nominated fifty-one (51) persons for appointment as Principal Secretaries.

Committal

Following receipt of the nominations from H.E. the President on 3rd November 2022, the Speaker of the National Assembly forwarded the names and curriculum vitae of the nominees to relevant Departmental Committees to conduct approval hearings and report back to the House pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 45(1) of the National Assembly Standing Orders.

Pursuant to the provisions of Article 118(1)(b) of the Constitution and Section 6(4) of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act (No. 33 of 2011), the general public is hereby notified that the Departmental Committees shall conduct Approval Hearings (Vetting) of the nominees for appointment to the position of Principal Secretaries from **Monday**, 14th **November**, 2022 at venues within Parliament Buildings starting from 9.00 a.m. as per the schedule below: -

 Higher Education Loans Board;
- Directorate of Criminal Investigations: and,
 Office of the Registrar of Political Parties.

Public Participation and Submission of Memoranda

The Departmental Committees are required under Article 118(1)(b) of the Constitution to involve the public in the Approval Hearings of the nominees. In addition, **Section (6)(9)** of the Parliamentary Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act provides that "any person may prior to the approval hearing and by written statement on oath, provide the Clerk with evidence contesting the suitability of a candidate to hold the office to which the candidate has been nominated".

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance with the requirements of Article 118(1)(b) of the Constitution and Section 6(9) of the Public Appointments (Parliamentary Approval) Act, the Departmental Committees invite interested members of the Public to submit any representations they may have, by written statements (affidavits) with supporting evidence on the suitability or otherwise of the candidates for appointment to the offices they have been nominated.

The representations may be forwarded to the Clerk of the National Assembly, P.O. Box 41842-00100, Nairobi; or hand-delivered to the Office of the Clerk, Main Parliament Buildings, Nairobi; or emailed to clerk.nationalassembly@parliament.go.ke to be received on or before Friday, 11th November, 2022 by 5.00 pm.
