11. GENERAL COMMENTS ON THE LEGISLATIVE PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE CONSTITUTION UNDER STANDING ORDER 114(7A)

Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 114(7A), Members made General Comments on the following Legislative Proposals to amend the Constitution—

(a) a Legislative Proposal by the Member for Mandera North (Hon. Maj. (Rtd) Bashir Sheikh) to amend Article 88 of the Constitution to provide that when the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission is not constituted, the Secretary of the Commission can perform the functions of the Commission that are limited to conducting by-elections under Article 101 (4)(b) of the Constitution.

(b) a Legislative Proposal by the Member for Thika Town (Hon. Alice Ng'ang'a) to amend Article 89 of the Constitution to protect 27 Constituencies that were protected for the First delimitation of electoral units in spite of not meeting the population quota requirement and which constituencies risk being merged with others when the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission conducts the Second review that is due.
