10. GUIDE ON CONSIDERATION OF THE PRESIDENT’S RESERVATIONS TO THE FINANCE BILL, 2024

“Honourable Members,

You will recall that on Tuesday, 23rd July 2024, I conveyed a Message from H.E. the President that in exercise of the powers conferred on him under Article 115(1)(b) of the Constitution, the President had referred the Finance Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 30 of 2024) back to the House for reconsideration. The reservations were referred to the Departmental Committee of Finance and National Planning for consideration. The Committee has since laid its report on the Memorandum.

Honourable Members, for the information of the Members, I wish to note that the Committee has recommended that the House **agrees with** the President’s Reservations that all the clauses of the Bill be deleted. In this regard, I wish to draw the attention of the House to the Speaker’s Communication of 28th July 2015 concerning the manner of consideration of the President’s reservations to a Bill and amendments thereto.

As per the guidance, any Member who wishes to move the House to reinstate any Clause of the Finance Bill, 2024 shall be required to marshal the support of at least **233 Members**. This is in keeping with the provisions of Article 115(4) of the Constitution, which requires that such a proposal be supported by at least two-thirds of the Members of the National Assembly.

Conversely, agreement with the President’s reservations and the recommendation to delete all the clauses of the Finance Bill, 2024 shall only require the support of a simple majority of the Members present and voting. This is in line with the provisions of Article 115(2)(a) of the Constitution as read with Article 122(1) of the Constitution.

The House is accordingly guided. I thank you!”
