INVITATION TO SUBMIT MEMORANDA

WHEREAS, Article 118(1) (b) of the Constitution requires Parliament to facilitate public participation and involvement in the legislative and other business of Parliament and its Committees;

AND WHEREAS, the Treaty Establishing the Inter-Governmental Authority on Development (IGAD) was tabled in the House on 4th June 2024 and committed to the **Departmental Committee on Defence**, **Intelligence**, and Foreign Relations for consideration and reporting to the House;

FURTHER, WHEREAS the purpose of the Treaty is to replace the Agreement Establishing the Inter-Governmental Authority on Development dated 21st March 1996 in order to widen and deepen cooperation to achieve sustainable development;

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance with Articles 118(1)(b) and 2(5) & (6) of the Constitution as well as Section 8 of the Treaty Making and Ratification Act, 2012, the **Departmental Committee on Defence, Intelligence and Foreign Relations** hereby invites members of the public and stakeholders to submit memoranda on the Treaty.
