2. The Proceedings were opened with Prayer.
3. **Presiding** – the Second Chairperson of Committees.

4. **LACK OF QUORUM AT COMMENCEMENT**

There being no Quorum present to commence business, the Second Chairperson of Committees ordered that the Quorum Bell be rung for Ten minutes;
