- (a) The **National Government Constituencies Fund** for purposes of ensuring reasonable access to exclusive national government functions in all constituencies as envisaged in Article 6(3) and ensure the participation of the people in the identification and implementation of priority national government programmes;
- (b) The **Senate Oversight Fund** to ensure that the Senate is adequately empowered and resourced to perform its oversight functions; and
- (c) The **National Government Affirmative Action Fund** to enhance the measures of the national government on affirmative action.
