ARTIFICIAL INTELLIGENCE IN THE LEGISLATURE

PROGRAMME OVERVIEW

This five-day programme equips officers of the Parliamentary Service Commission (PSC) with the knowledge, skills and attitudes needed to adopt and leverage Artificial Intelligence (AI) in their parliamentary and administrative duties. Through hands-on exercises in prompt engineering, AI-assisted drafting, research, analysis, content generation and workflow automation, participants build practical AI competencies while gaining a critical understanding of associated risks such as hallucinations, bias, misinformation, privacy and cybersecurity concerns.

PROGRAMME RATIONALE

AI is rapidly transforming how organisations operate worldwide, and legislatures are increasingly adopting AI-powered tools to boost efficiency, strengthen evidence-based decision-making and improve citizen engagement. As Parliament advances its digital transformation agenda, staff across legislative, research, legal, finance, HR, communication, ICT, records, security and administrative functions will need practical AI competencies to safeguard institutional integrity and public trust while improving service delivery. This programme equips learners with requisite skills to use AI tools safely, effectively and responsibly in support of Parliament's constitutional mandate.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

By the end of the programme, learners will be able to explain the fundamental concepts and applications of AI in the parliamentary environment, demonstrate the use of AI tools to enhance legislative, administrative, research, communication and operational functions, apply prompt engineering techniques to generate accurate and context-specific outputs, use AI technologies to support drafting, summarisation, research, data analysis and workflow automation, and apply best practices for the responsible, secure and effective use of AI.

TARGET GROUP

The course is designed for Members and Staff serving in legislatures at various levels of government, including officers serving in legislative committees, research, legal, finance, human resource, communication, ICT, records management, security, protocol and support service functions.



COURSE CONTENT

The programme covers the fundamentals of AI and its parliamentary applications; the use of AI tools for legislative drafting, research, summarisation and content development; prompt engineering techniques for maximising output accuracy and relevance; AI-powered workflow automation and data analysis; the risks and limitations of AI, including hallucinations, bias, misinformation and privacy concerns; and the ethical, legal and governance frameworks for responsible AI use in Parliament.

BENEFITS OF ATTENDING

Participants will gain practical skills in using AI tools for drafting, summarisation and workflow automation, develop effective prompt engineering techniques, learn to identify and address AI hallucinations, bias and misinformation, strengthen their awareness of ethical, legal and governance considerations, and be better placed to leverage emerging technologies in support of parliamentary excellence.
