Additionally, learners should be able to apply the knowledge, skills, and competencies required to plan, coordinate, and implement effective security, emergency response, estate management, and Chamber operations in support of a safe, secure, and resilient legislative institution.

TARGET GROUP

The course is designed for Serjeant-At-Arms and other security officers in legislatures.

COURSE CONTENT

The course covers critical infrastructure protection, VIP protection, global and regional security challenges facing legislatures, first aid management, the application of modern technology in security, coordinating multi-agency security setups, disaster management and drills, estate management, Chamber duties of the Serjeant-At-Arms, conflict management and resolution, and fire-fighting techniques.
