THE STATUTE LAW (MISCELLANEOUS AMENDMENTS) BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 45 OF 2016)

Notice is given that the Chairperson of the Departmental Committee on Justice and Legal Affairs, intends to move the following amendments to the Statute Law (Miscellaneous Amendments) Bill, 2016, National Assembly Bills No. 45, at the Committee Stage—

SCHEDULE

THAT the Schedule to the Bill be amended in the proposed amendments to the Retirements Benefits (Deputy President and Designated State Officers) Act, No. 8 of 2015 by -

- (i) inserting the following new item immediately before the proposed amendment to section 3-

s.2 Insert the following new definitions in their proper alphabetical sequence—

“retired Chief Justice” means a person who, having held the office of Chief Justice, has ceased to hold the office as such in the manner specified in the Constitution;

“retired Deputy Chief Justice” means a person who, having held the office of Deputy Chief Justice, has ceased to hold office as such in the manner specified in the Constitution.

- (ii) deleting the proposed amendment to section 3 and substituting therefor with the following new amendment—

s.3 Delete and substitute therefor the following new section—

Persons entitled to
benefits.

3. Subject to sections 5(3) and 15, the persons entitled to the benefits conferred by this Act shall be persons who—

(a) at any time after the 1st January, 1993, retire as Deputy President, Prime Minister, Vice-President or Speaker; and

(b) at any time after the 27th August, 2010, retire as Chief Justice or Deputy Chief Justice.

THAT, pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 28 on the Calendar of the Assembly (Regular Sessions), this House adjourns until Tuesday, March 14, 2017.

The House resolved on Wednesday, January 25, 2017 as follows:-

- II. THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 97(4), each speech in a debate on **Bills sponsored by a Committee, the Leader of the Majority Party or the Leader of the Minority Party** be limited as follows:- A maximum of forty five (45) minutes for the Mover, in moving and fifteen minutes (15) in replying, a maximum of thirty (30) minutes for the Chairperson of the relevant Committee (if the Bill is not sponsored by the relevant Committee), and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen Minutes (15) each (if the Bill is not sponsored by either of them); and that priority in speaking be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party, the Leader of the Minority Party and the Chairperson of the relevant Departmental Committee, in that order.
- III. THAT**, notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 97(4), this House orders that, each speech in a debate on a **Report of a Committee**, including a Report of a Joint Committee of the Houses of Parliament or any other Report submitted to the House, be limited as follows: -A maximum of sixty (60) minutes for the Mover in moving and thirty (30) minutes in replying, and a maximum of ten (10) minutes for any other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that order.

- IV. THAT,** notwithstanding the provisions of Standing Order 97(4), this House orders that, the debate on any Motion for the **Adjournment** of the House to a day other than the next normal Sitting Day in accordance with the Calendar of the Assembly, be limited to a maximum of three (3) hours with not more than five (5) minutes for each Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of ten (10) minutes each; and that priority be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, in that order; provided that, when the period of Recess proposed by any such motion does not exceed ten (10) days, the debate shall be limited to a maximum of thirty minutes (30), and shall be strictly confined to the question of the adjournment.
