#### 6. <u>PROCEDURAL MOTION</u> - <u>LIMITATION OF SPEAKING TIME ON</u> <u>SPECIFIED MOTIONS</u>

Motion made and Question proposed –

**THAT**, notwithstanding the resolution of the House of 10<sup>th</sup> February 2016 regarding limitation of speaking time during debates, this House further resolves that, during the Special Sittings of today, January 17, 2017, debate on the motions specified hereunder shall be limited as follows-

- (a) Motion for consideration of nominee for appointment as the Chairperson of the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission: A maximum of two (2) hours with not more than twenty (20) minutes for the Mover and five (5) minutes for each other Member speaking, including the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, and that five (5) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply, and further that priority in speaking shall be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party in that order;
- (b) Motion for consideration of nominees for appointment as the Chairperson and Members of the Independent Electoral and Boundaries Commission: A maximum of four hours with not more than thirty (30) minutes for the Mover and ten (10) minutes for each other Member speaking, except the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party, who shall be limited to a maximum of fifteen (15) minutes each, and that ten (10) minutes before the expiry of the time, the Mover shall be called upon to reply, and further that priority in speaking shall be accorded to the Leader of the Majority Party and the Leader of the Minority Party in that order.

(The Leader of the Majority Party)

There being no Members wishing to debate; Question put and agreed to.
