**APPROVAL OF THE MEDIATED VERSION OF THE DIVISION OF  
REVENUE BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 10 OF 2025)**

**Honourable Members,**

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41(4), I wish to report to the House that during the recess period, I received a Message from the Senate regarding the approval of the Mediated Version of the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 10 of 2025).
2. The Message conveys that on Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> June 2025, in accordance with the provisions of Article 113(2) of the Constitution, the Senate considered and **approved** the mediated version of **the Division of Revenue Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 10 of 2025)** in the form developed and agreed by the Mediation Committee.
3. **Honourable Members**, you will recall that the Bill was committed to a mediation committee pursuant to Article 112(2)(b) of the Constitution, following the National Assembly's rejection of Senate amendments to the Bill on Tuesday, 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2025.
4. Consequent to this, the House considered the Report of the Mediation Committee and **approved** the mediated version of the Bill on Thursday, 19<sup>th</sup> June 2025, in the form developed by the Mediation Committee.

**5. Honourable Members,** the approval of the mediated version of the Division of Revenue Bill, 2025 by both Houses of Parliament concluded its bicameral consideration. In this regard, and in accordance with the provisions of Article 113(3) of the Constitution, I did present the Bill to His Excellency the President for Assent. The Bill was subsequently assented to and is now an Act of Parliament.

**6.** The House is accordingly informed.
