1. The House assembled at Thirty Minutes past Two O'clock
2. The Proceedings were opened with Prayer
3. **Presiding** – the Honourable Speaker
4. **QUORUM AT COMMENCEMENT OF THE HOUSE**
And there being no quorum present to commence business, the Honourable Speaker, ordered that the Quorum Bell be rung for ten minutes;
And Quorum having been attained within ten minutes, business commenced.

5. ADMINISTRATION OF OATH

The Speaker administered Oath to—

6. PETITIONS

The Speaker reported the following Petition –

“Honourable Members, Article 119 of the Constitution accords any person the right to petition Parliament to consider any matter within its authority. Further, Standing Order 225(2)(b) requires the Speaker to report to the House any Petition other than those presented by a Member.

Honourable Members, in this regard, I wish to report to the House that my Office has received a petition from *James Kago of Identification Card No. 233xxxx94, Treasurer for the Haemophilia Association*, that deals with the management of haemophilia and other bleeding disorders among patients and children in the country.

The Petitioner states that the right to health is a fundamental human right guaranteed under Article 43(1)(a) of the Constitution of Kenya, which provides that every person, including children, has the right to the highest attainable standard of health, including access to health care services.

Honourable Members, the Petitioner is concerned that children and adults living with haemophilia experience frequent, unpredictable, and sometimes life-threatening bleeding episodes, which significantly diminish their quality of life and may result in disabling joint disease (arthropathy), chronic pain, missed school or work, and reduced life expectancy.

Honourable Members, the Petitioner explains that the treatment and management of haemophilia, especially for children who require preventive therapy (prophylaxis), are extremely costly, specialised, and time consuming, leading to severe physical, financial, emotional and psychological strain on families and caregivers.

The Petitioner avers that haemophilia affects approximately 1 in every 10,000 individuals, and of an estimated 4,500 patients in Kenya, including a substantial number of children, and only 1,265 equivalent to 23% have been identified, demonstrating an urgent need for continuous nationwide screening, early detection and child focused outreach.

Honourable Members, the Petitioner further explains that the existing data on haemophilia and bleeding disorders and in particular among children is fragmented, uncoordinated, and incomplete, necessitating the establishment of a national patient registry that captures accurate demographic, diagnostic and treatment information to support planning and service delivery.

Honourable Members, the Petitioner states that donations of clotting factor concentrates currently received are inconsistent and insufficient, providing only 30% of the required factor levels for the 1,265 diagnosed patients and children; at times forcing families to rely on blood-derived products that require hospital admission and carry risks of complications.

The Petitioner is concerned that the existing donation programme supplying clotting factor concentrates has a 70% deficit and is expected to end within two years, creating a looming treatment crisis that will particularly endanger children who rely on prophylactic factor replacement to prevent life-threatening bleeds.

The Petitioner further states that only a few fully operational haemophilia treatment centres exist across the country, insufficient for the needs of both adult and child patients nationwide; therefore, there is a need for more centres in all referral hospitals equipped with diagnostic machines for coagulation testing and supportive services such as physiotherapy and child-focused care.

The Petitioner's efforts to adequately address the plight of haemophilia patients and children living with bleeding disorders in the country have not yielded meaningful or sustainable progress.

Honourable Members, the Petitioners therefore pray that the National Assembly investigates and inquire into this matter and—

- (i) recommends formal recognition of clotting factor concentrates as essential medicine for the treatment of haemophilia in both adults and children, and ensuring sustainable availability within the Kenyan market;
- (ii) recommends to the Ministry of Health to establish additional haemophilia treatment centres nationwide; enhancement of diagnostic capacity; improved training of healthcare workers (including paediatric specialists); review of medical curricula to incorporate the management of haemophilia and bleeding disorders; and increased funding for awareness, particularly for early childhood screening;
- (iii) recommends recognition of haemophilia as a disabling condition to enable registration of both adult and child patients with the National Council for Persons with Disabilities (NCPWD), and support the inclusion of haemophilia under the Social Health Insurance Fund (SHIF); and
- (iv) makes any other recommendations it deems fit to address the plight of adult and child patients living with haemophilia and other bleeding disorders in Kenya.

Honourable Members, having established that the matter raised in the Petition is well within the authority of this House, and further, that the matters raised in this Petition are not pending before any court of law, constitutional, or legal body, I hereby commit the Petition to the Departmental Committee on Health for consideration. The Committee is required to consider the Petition and report its findings to the House and to the Petitioner in accordance with Standing Order 227(2). I thank you.”

(a) Mandatory Guidance and Counselling Programme in all Primary and Secondary Schools in Kenya

THAT, aware that learners in primary and secondary schools across the country are increasingly exposed to social, psychological and behavioural challenges, including drug and substance abuse, indiscipline, school unrest and academic underperformance; **noting that** there has been a disturbing rise in cases of sexual violence against children, including incidents where minors are abused or killed by individuals known to them, including relatives and caregivers, thereby exposing learners to trauma and long-term psychological harm; **further noting that** many learners come from homes affected by domestic violence, family instability, economic hardship and other social pressures that adversely affect their emotional wellbeing, safety and concentration in school; **concerned that** guidance and counselling services in most primary and secondary schools remain informal, inadequately structured and under-resourced, with no standardized national framework to ensure professionalism, accountability and effective delivery; **appreciating that** structured psychosocial support, life skills training, child protection awareness and early intervention during formative years are critical in safeguarding learners, strengthening resilience, promoting discipline and improving academic outcomes; **this House therefore resolves that**, the Government, through the Ministry of Education:-

- (i) introduces a mandatory, structured and time-tabled Guidance and Counselling Programme in all public and private primary and secondary schools in Kenya;
- (ii) develops and implements a national policy framework providing for the recruitment, accreditation and deployment of professionally trained school counsellors;
- (iii) integrates mental health education, child protection awareness, personal safety training and life skills development into the school curriculum;
- (iv) allocates adequate resources to support counselling services in schools; and
- (v) establishes clear coordination and referral mechanisms between schools, child protection institutions and relevant government agencies to ensure effective safeguarding of learners.
