**REFERRAL OF THE FINANCE BILL (NATIONAL ASSEMBLY BILL NO. 26 OF 2026) TO A COMMITTEE**

**WHEREAS** the House, by a resolution passed on 11<sup>th</sup> February 2026, **ordered** that, should a Bill be published during the Short or Long Recesses of the Fifth Session, the Speaker shall, upon determination that the Bill is of priority, **forthwith refer such Bill to the relevant Committee for consideration pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 127** (*Committal of Bills to Committees and public participation*), report such fact to the House upon resumption, and cause the Bill to be read a First Time upon its next Sitting;

**IN FURTHERANCE** of this **Order** by the House, and appreciating the central role of a Finance Bill in the setting out of the revenue-raising measures for the national government, it is notified that the Finance Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 26 of 2026), which was published on 5<sup>th</sup> May 2026, has been determined to be of priority, given the statutory timelines and the need for carrying out of extensive public participation;

**NOW THEREFORE**, it is hereby **NOTIFIED** to all Members of the National Assembly and the general public –

**(1) THAT**, the Finance Bill (National Assembly Bill No. 26 of 2026) now stand referred to the **Departmental Committee on Finance and National Planning** for consideration;

- (2) THAT,** in view of the priority accorded to the Bill, the Committee is required to expedite consideration and submit its report upon resumption of the House, for circulation to all Members;
- (3) THAT,** upon resumption of the House, the Bill shall be Read a First time and the House Business Committee shall expedite consideration of the Bill; and
- (4) THAT,** the Clerk is hereby required to transmit this Notification to all Members of the National Assembly and facilitate the Committee to undertake the necessary public participation on the Bill.
