3. **QUORUM OF THE SENATE**

The Speaker, having counted the Honourable Senators present at the commencement of the Sitting and confirming that there was no Quorum, directed that the Bell be rung for ten minutes, pursuant to Standing Order 40;

And there being no Quorum at the expiry of the ten minutes, the Speaker directed that the Bell be rung for a further ten minutes;

And there being a Quorum before the expiry of the further ten minutes;

The Speaker invited the Clerk to call the Orders of the day.

4. **QUESTIONS AND STATEMENTS**

QUESTIONS

- i) Question No. 040 by the Senator for Kajiado County (Sen. Seki Ole Kanar, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Energy and Petroleum on delayed compensation of landowners along the wayleave corridors of the Kajiado-Namanga, Sultan Hamud-Oloitoktok and UMMA University-Konza transmission line projects was answered by the Cabinet Secretary.
- ii) Question No. 041 by the Senator for Kajiado County (Sen. Seki Ole Kanar, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Energy and Petroleum on the status of electricity connectivity in Kajiado County was answered by the Cabinet Secretary.
- iii) Question No. 042 by Nominated Senator (Sen. Hamida Kibwana, MP), asked on her behalf by Nominated Senator (Sen. Beth Syengo, MP), to the Cabinet Secretary for Energy and Petroleum on the vulnerability of electricity infrastructure to heavy rains, flooding and other adverse weather conditions was answered by the Cabinet Secretary.

- iv) Question No. 024 by the Senator for Kisumu County (Sen. (Prof.) Tom Ojienda, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Investments, Trade and Industry on National Government support towards sustainable market management in the counties was answered by the Cabinet Secretary.
- v) Question No. 037 by the Senator for Marsabit County (Sen. Mohamed Chute, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Lands, Public Works, Housing and Urban Development on the delayed issuance of title deeds to allottees of Plot/Parcel No. 570–686 situated in Marsabit County was deferred in the absence of the Cabinet Secretary.
- vi) Question No. 045 by Nominated Senator (Sen. Hamida Kibwana, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Lands, Public Works, Housing and Urban Development on the alignment of urban housing development with infrastructure planning and provision in Kenya was deferred in the absence of the Cabinet Secretary.
- vii) Question No. 043 by the Senator for West Pokot County (Sen. (Rev.) Julius Recha, MP) to the Cabinet Secretary for Energy and Petroleum on Socio-economic benefits of the Turkwel hydroelectric power generation project for the local communities was dropped in the absence of the Senator.
