MESSAGE FROM THE SENATE

ON PASSAGE OF THE COUNTY ALLOCATION OF REVENUE BILL
(SENATE BILL NO. 10 OF 2026)

Honourable Members,

1. Pursuant to the provisions of Standing Order 41(4), I wish to report to the House that I have received a Message from the Senate regarding the passage of the County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bill No. 10 of 2026).
2. **Honourable Members**, the Message conveys that the Senate considered and passed the County Allocation of Revenue Bill (Senate Bill No. 10 of 2026) on 17th June 2026, **with amendments**. The Bill, which was published vide Kenya Gazette Supplement No. 107 of 30th April 2026, seeks to provide for equitable allocation of revenue raised nationally among the county governments for the 2026/2027 financial year and the responsibilities of the national Government and county governments pursuant to the said allocations.
3. Having passed the said Bill, the Senate now seeks the concurrence of the National Assembly in accordance with the provisions of Article 110(4) of the Constitution.

4. **Honourable Members**, noting the critical role of the Bill in the funding of the operations of devolved units of governance in the country, it is imperative that the House considers the Bill on a priority basis. In this regard, I have directed the Clerk to schedule the Bill for First Reading during the next sitting of the House. In the meantime, the Bill is hereby committed to the **Budget and Appropriations Committee** for consideration in terms of the provisions of Articles 110 and 114 of the Constitution.
5. The Committee is required to prioritise consideration of the Bill, and report to the House by **Tuesday, 23rd June 2026**, with appropriate recommendations to inform deliberations by the House.
6. The House is accordingly guided.
